2. The ability for the owner to be able to afford to produce food on their land with rates/water/labour and other contributing factors. I believe in organic and clean systems that do not cause degradation of the land and environment within the area and region.

3. The legal capacity to hold people to account that wilfully pollute and destroy environments and/or walk away leaving the mess for others to try to clean up. This has to stop now.

Clean and safe food production and land use that benefits multi generations and big picture thinking for the land and the area involved.

5. Please take climate action seriously and factor this into account in particular with the mapping of areas and projections of future change. We need to work together to ensure transparency and fairness going forward whilst respecting those who work in the industries that grow the food. That they can do the work that they need to feed us and still live a valued life with the land.
