Subject: Surveillance of Potable Water in Meat and
Game Export Premises

1. Background

The previous circular outlines minimum sampling frequencies for physico-chemical testing of potable process/drinking water. (Appendix B, table 3). The table of frequencies is followed by a note requiring head office notification of when samples are to be taken.

2. Aim

To provide notification that premises undertake category B testing.

3. Procedure

- 3.1 All premises covered by the previous circular are to undertake category B tests on an ongoing basis in accordance with the stated frequencies.
- 3.2 Premises without test results or results outside the specified **periods** are to obtain results by 1 April 1990.
- 3.3 Premises applying for a licence are to supply test results at the time of application. Unsatisfactory results will affect the operation of the premises.

4. Implementation

By 1 April 1990.
