

Prohibited in Waiuku Forest



No access to mine site at any time.



No access to rifle range at any time. (inside red border on map) No hunting or firearms in forest at any time.



No access to any area where tree work or forest operations are being carried out.



Fires not permitted at any time any day of the year.



Take your rubbish with you when you leave the forest.



Do not cut, fell or remove any live or dead trees.



The use of motorbikes , quad bikes or side by side is NOT permitted

Visiting Waiuku Forest



Stay away from grazing cattle.



Gravel roads are slippery when wet or muddy: 4WD recommended after rain.



Stay away from broken, dying, leaning or falling trees.



Respect other people and animals using the forest.



All animals must be under direct control of owner at all times.



Respect and comply with fenced areas at all times.
