### Introduction

This introduction is not part of the ACVM Requirement but is intended to indicate its general effect.

# **Purpose**

The purpose of this ACVM Requirement is to revoke the Waiver of Fees, Charges, and Levies for Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines, issued 18 August 2015.

# **Background**

The Waiver of Fees, Charges, and Levies for Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines, issued 18 August 2015, provided partial waivers for the following fees payable under the Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines (Fees, Charges, and Levies) Regulations 2015:

- assessing whether an application to register a trade name product complies with section 10 of the Act; and
- registering in the register of trade name products, in accordance with section 21(1)(d) of the Act, a trade name product or a variation of 1 or more conditions on a registered trade name product.

The main purpose of this Waiver of Fees, Charges, and Levies for Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines was to prevent over recovery after applying cost recovery criteria in accordance with section 81 and section 81H of the Act. These waivers are no longer required because the regulations have been amended to address these over recovery concerns.

# Who should read this ACVM Requirement?

The ACVM requirement should be read by anyone registering a trade name product under the Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines Act 1997.
