The specific requirements included within this schedule are in addition to the requirements of Section 1.4 Requirements for seed for sowing and 1.5 Documentation, of the import health standard 155.02.05: Seeds for sowing, which can be viewed at the following link: https://www.mpi.govt.nz/importing/plants/seeds-for-sowing/ The phytosanitary measures are proposed to manage two viruses (<i>Cucumber green mottle mosaic virus</i> (CGMMV) and <i>Kyuri green mottle mosaic virus</i> (KGMMV)) which are seed transmitted in cucurbitaceae species.
