<p>To identify the risk factors other than hazards and ensure that appropriate controls are included in the RMP so that the products are fit for intended purpose. These risk factors are: risks from false or misleading labelling, and risks to wholesomeness.</p>

Incorrect claims for free range, barn, caged or organic eggs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Checking of details on all new labels.</li> <li>Checking that correct label is in use at all steps (collection, storage and transfer, at grading etc).</li> </ul>	Attachment K Pages 3 - 9
Incorrect best before dates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Daily checking for correct date on labels.</li> </ul>	Attachment K
