Otherwise the application must be made as soon as practicable after the need for the waiver becomes apparent, and before the deadline for submission of the associated mandatory emissions return.

- assignment of a forestry right or lease.
- grant of forestry right or lease
- expiry or termination of forestry right or lease
- letter(s) from inventory contractor(s) stating reasons why they are unable to collect the FMA information in the required time frame.
