All Commodities: Transcription Errors

CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of any animal product or live animal where the documentation has been found to have a transcription error.

Replaces CTO direction CTO 2013 057

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Lucy Johnston, Manager, Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for any animal product or live animal to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures:

Transcription errors on documentation accompanying any animal product or live animal are accepted where:

- a. there is evidence that the error is the consequence of transcription; or
- b. official or veterinary correspondence explains the error to the satisfaction of MPI.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
