**Notes:****1. Treatments**

You only need to detail any treatment which remains within the withholding period. If you do not know the withholding period, **a 63 day withholding period must be applied.**

**2. MRL and MPL**

MRL means, in relation to a residue, the maximum permissible level of that residue as specified in the Food Notice: Maximum Residue Levels for Agricultural Compounds. MPL means the maximum permissible level at which a substance may be present in animal material or animal product as specified in the current edition of the Animal Products Notice: Maximum Permissible Levels.

A MRL or MPL may be exceeded if the poultry have been exposed to an agricultural compound (including veterinary medicines or agricultural chemicals (that have been applied to land, places or water in which plants or animals are managed)) and sufficient time has not elapsed since the treatment or exposure, such that unacceptable residues may remain.

**3. Feeds**

A withdrawal period would be applied by a feed manufacturer if the feed contains a component that must not be fed to the poultry within a period of time prior to their slaughter to ensure that residue levels are not breached.

**4. Electronic Submission.**

This declaration may be provided electronically, but only with the consent of the recipient.
