The challenge:	 A lack of planning capability to synchronise a breeding and finishing beef farming operation. A lack of expertise in finishing beef as Te Tii Tapuaetahi Incorporation (Inc) are new to this business.
Purpose of the project:	To develop a five year operational plan that will synchronise the Inc's breeding and finishing operations.
Project outcomes:	By developing a comprehensive five year operational farm plan, it will lead to: • seamless integration of a new business (beef finishing) with the existing (beef breeding) • sourcing investment for capital works • recruitment of new staff and the right skill sets • an increase in the Inc's capability (knowledge and skill sets) • connecting the Inc with the right business partners • increased profit margins and on farm productivity.
