



**CTO Direction**

**Equivalent measures for consignments non-compliant caravans with VEHICLE-ALL**

**CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTO Plants: 2016 0073**

Pursuant to section 27(1) (d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, give the following direction for measures, different from those required by section 4.3 in the import health standard (IHS): *Vehicles, Machinery and Tyres* – VEHICLE-ALL, that may be applied to this particular consignment of caravans sourced from the United States of America (USA). Treatment with:

Methyl bromide fumigation at 16 g/m<sup>3</sup> for 12 hours at 10°C or greater with a 50% end point reading and a maximum post-treatment storage period of 96 hours prior to loading.

All other relevant sections of the IHS: VEHICLE-ALL for vehicles and machinery sourced from the USA must be complied with.

This direction takes effect from the 20 October 2016, and may apply to consignment C2016/364211, two Airstream caravans, sourced from the USA which are not compliant with the measures required by section 4.3 in the import health standard (IHS) VEHICLE-ALL.
