

QUARTERLY PROGRESS SUMMARY: October – December 2016

High Performance Mānuka Plantations PGP Programme

Summary of progress during this quarter

- Survival and growth of trial manuka plantations were assessed in spring 2016.
- Nectar and honey samples were collected from the four main plantation sites; these will be analysed next quarter.
- Expert review completed of the modelling approach used in the predictive tool for plantation mānuka.

Key highlights and achievements

- Technical notes for the planting and management of mānuka plantations for honey have been updated incorporating new research results from work undertaken in 2016.
- Manuka Farming NZ has confirmed sales of 1 million high performance mānuka seedlings for planting in 2017. The planting target for 2018 is 2 million seedlings.

Upcoming

- Analysis of honey and nectar samples from the trial plantations.
- Progress the creation of the predictive tool.
