The schedule of special entry conditions for fresh *Citrus* spp. from Egypt has been suspended dated 26 February 2018. This means that fresh *Citrus* spp. from Egypt is not eligible for import into New Zealand.

The MPI Chief Technical Officer (CTO) believes that based on new technical information, the current treatment rates used for fruit flies, *Bactrocera zonata* and *Ceratitis capitata*, no longer manage the risk to an appropriate level and, therefore, does not enable the purposes of the Biosecurity Act 1993 (Part 3) to be achieved.

A draft IHS for Fresh Citrus spp. for Human Consumption is out for consultation.
