

### Third Minute of Marlborough Salmon Farm Relocation Advisory Panel

1. In the Second Minute issued by the Panel dated 20 April, 2017 the 10<sup>th</sup> of May 2017 was fixed for three meetings of expert witnesses, including one in relation to the topic of effects on King Shags.
2. On 1 May, 2017, the Panel received a memorandum from counsel for Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand Incorporated advising that its expert witness, Dr Fisher, would be unavailable for a meeting on 10 May, 2017.
3. Arrangements have now been made for the meeting of all the experts involved in the King Shag issue to take place at 10:30 a.m. on Monday 15 May, 2017.
4. The date for the meeting on the topic of economic effects of significance remains as Wednesday 10 May, commencing at 10:30 a.m. The topic of landscape has been shifted to the earlier date of Tuesday 9 May at 3:00 p.m.
