

QUARTERLY PROGRESS SUMMARY: April – June 2017 High Performance Mānuka Plantations PGP Programme

Summary of progress during this quarter

• GIS mapping has been undertaken to identify land areas within the North Island that will support mānuka plantations for medical grade honey production.

Key highlights and achievements

- Manuka Farming New Zealand exhibition and trade site at National Field Days, 14-17 June 2017, Mystery Creek. The site was well attended with the inclusion of miniseminars covering programme learnings.
- A preliminary working version of the predictive tool for plantation mānuka has been developed and is being tested by the partners. The predictive tool is a decision support tool with the ability to deliver detailed reports on the physical and financial performance of potential mānuka plantations.

• Testing and continued development of the predictive tool for plantation manuka.
