

Conditions of Recognition

(Persons recognised to perform verification functions and activities under the Wine Act 2003)

These conditions are issued pursuant to section 76 of the Wine Act 2003 and are standard conditions attached to the recognition of any person who is recognised to perform verification functions and activities under the Wine Act. These conditions may be revoked, amended or added to by the Director-General as provided for by section 76.

Any term or expression that is defined in the Wine Act 2003 or regulations made under that Act, or in the Wine (Recognised Agencies and Persons) Notice 2007, and used in these conditions has the same meaning as in the Act, regulations or notice.

CONDITION 1

Recognised persons must comply with any relevant notices of direction issued pursuant to section 57(1) of the Wine Act 2003.

CONDITION 2

To maintain recognition, the recognised person must—

- a. take appropriate action in response to a critical non-compliance; and
- b. follow up non-compliances or corrective action requests.

If a recognised person fails to meet this condition, the Director-General may invoke the procedures in the Act for suspension and/or withdrawal of recognition.

CONDITION 3

Where a function is required to be performed by a recognised person under the management of a recognised agency, when that person ceases to be employed, engaged, or used by that agency, the person's recognition in relation to performing the function for that agency expires.
