NZ Delegation Report of the 41st session of CAC

Major outcomes of interest to New Zealand were as follows:

The 41st session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission:

- The revised date marking provisions in the General Standard for labelling of prepackaged foods were adopted at step 8. New Zealand led this work in CCFL;
- Advanced the New Zealand initiated work on Guidelines for risk analysis of instances of contaminants in food where there is no regulatory level or risk management framework established' to step 5 unanimously'. New Zealand is co leading this work in collaboration with the Netherlands;
- Advanced the compositional provisions in the Revised draft standard for follow up formula to step 5. New Zealand is co-leading this work.
- The CAC made good progress on the revision of its Strategic Plan and confirmed its intention to have the revised plan adopted at its next meeting in 2019.
- Approved new work on revision of Guidelines on Sampling(NZ leading this work in CCMAS); Development of guidance on use of simplified nutrition information on the front of pack(CCFL); Guidance for the management of microbiological foodborne crises/outbreaks(CCFH)
