Quarterly Progress Report January to March 2012 (Quarter 3 2011/12) Executive Summary

There are four projects / objectives in the High Performance Manuka Plantations PGP Programme.

Work was progressed in the following areas during Quarter 3 2011/12:

Objective 1: Determine the key environmental factors which influence plant growth, flowering, nectar yield and nectar quality through controlled greenhouse trials

Good progress is being made with the PhD student now on board. Soil types were selected and tested in preparation for the greenhouse trial assessing the effects of soils on a range of Manuka clones.

Objective 2: Determine the effects of site, microsite and stocking rate on growth, flowering, nectar yield and quality

Monitoring of established Manuka variety trial plots and broad acre Manuka plantings was undertaken at two sites in the lower North Island.
