Quarterly Progress Report Summary

January to March 2014

The Stakeholders In Methyl Bromide Reduction (STIMBR) PGP programme is a multi-strand research programme that seeks to reduce methyl bromide emissions to the atmosphere by 2020 and find alternative phytosanitary treatments.

Notable progress during the third quarter of 2014/15 was achieved with the decision to progress the methyl bromide destruction research past a stop / go milestone so that additional information can be provided in July 2014 to inform a clear decision on any future work to develop this technology.

As the programme is coming to a close at the end of June 2014, it is focused on completing the work load it has contracted to deliver. STIMBR is preparing its Research strategy for 2014-20.
