## **Sheep – Horizon Three**

## Progress Report for the Period October 2017 to December 2017

The Sheep – Horizon Three programme is half way through its second season and is making progress in a number of fundamental areas.

## Highlights from this period include:

- Market insights work across new potential markets and immersion projects.
- Successful trials of new products undertaken with market launches now in the planning phase.
- The farm nutritional trial has yielded exceptional results in both increased milk volume and lamb weights. Flock average is tracking to around 200L /ewe with the top 25% in excess of 250L/ewe (note: this is prior to any imported genetic gains).
- First lambs with imported genetics are tracking well in both health and maturity.
- Hybrid Pilot Farm site is tracking to target ahead of the 2018/2019 first season.
- Bovine to Ovine Conversion Pilot Farm site has been identified and is also targeting first milking in the 2018/2019 season.
- Farm Open Day was conducted in early December 2017 at Cambridge and Taupō. The day was a combination of industry development discussions, sharing of learnings from the programme, interactive panel session with the farm team and a tour of the Taupō site. This was once again widely attended with over 100 people interested in the potential industry (over 200 have attended since the programme began).
