ii) the total area is **greater than 5 hectares**;

iii) there is **no individual area less than 1 hectare**;

iv) has had **NO** existing exotic or native tree cover greater than 1 hectare since 1989;

v) has **NOT** been cleared of closed canopy forest cover since 1999;

vi) it excludes all ineligible land (e.g. Special Wildlife Interest, Recommended for Protection, Archaeological site, etc).

The proposed treatment plan:

i) establishment year(s) and species included in the application;

ii) treatment type, estimated area, stems per hectare and maintenance plan included in the application;

iii) any site specific requirements on the treatment plan included;

iv) an aerial photographic plan showing the proposed area to be treated including:

a) any internal planting boundaries where different planting years, species or erosion treatments are intended;

b) existing and/or proposed fencing;

c) any excluded Closed Canopy Indigenous Scrub within the proposed grant area; and

d) any access considerations.
