Jelly Fish: Dried

CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of jelly fish (dried)

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Nasser Ahmed, Senior Adviser (Animal Imports), Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give direction for jelly fish (dried) to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the *Import Health Standard for Marine Fisheries Products for Human Consumption from all Countries (FISMARIC.ALL; 6 October 2008)*:

Clause 6 (Eligibility): Jelly fish (dried) – all species

Part C (Clearance Procedure): Biosecurity clearance may be given to jelly fish (all species) if dried, commercially manufactured and packaged.
