Otinem (Weevilnem): wettable powder containing nematodes

**CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of Otinem (Weevilnem), wettable powder containing *Heterohabditis bacteriophora* (nematode), relating only to permit 2013051737 and any subsequent amendments and/or renewals.**

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager – Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for Otinem (Weevilnem), a wettable powder containing *Heterohabditis bacteriophora* (nematode), to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable import health standard for the importation of invertebrates into New Zealand (INVNONIC.ALL):

Clause 10.3: as long as Otinem (Weevilnem) is accompanied by a permit to import and is commercially manufactured and packaged, no direction to a Transitional Facility is required. The product may be given biosecurity clearance.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
