#### **1.** Statutory authority

Pursuant to section 60 of the Animal Products Act 1999, I notify the following overseas market access requirements, entitled Bumble Bees to People's Republic of China.

### 2. People's Republic of China Requirements

Bumble bees (*Bombus* species) exported from New Zealand to People's Republic of China must comply with the import requirements of People's Republic of China listed in this notice as follows:

- 2.1 An official veterinarian of New Zealand must certify the following:
  - 2.1.1 The bees described below are a product of New Zealand
  - 2.1.2 Trachael mite (*Acarapis woodi*), Asian mite (*Tropilaelaps clareae*) and European foulbrood (*Melissococcus pluton*) do not occur in New Zealand
  - 2.1.3 The following honey bee (*Apis mellifera*) diseases: American foulbrood (*Paenibacillus larvae larvae*), varroa mite (*Varroa destructor*) and nosema disease *Nosema apis* are not diseases of bumble bees (*Bombus* species) in New Zealand.

# 3. **Definitions**

For the purposes of this document:

Any term or expression that is defined in the Animal Products Act 1999 and used, but not defined in this document, has the same meaning as in this Act.

# Explanatory note

This OMAR is based on the requirements provided in the export certificate for Bumble Bees (Bombus species) to People's Republic of China dated 19 November 2004.
