CTO Direction: CTOPlants:20140024 Irradiated horse feed products – 15kGy equivalence

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, *[Signature]*, give the following directions for import permits to be issued for animal feed products, potentially containing whole seed, to specify that a phytosanitary certificate or a manufacturers treatment certificate certifying irradiation at 15kGy prior to export is equivalent to the requirement for 25kGy in the IHS *Importation into NZ of Processed Animal feeds of Plant Origin*. Irradiation at the 15kGy rate is considered to effectively manage the risks identified in the IHS

All other relevant sections of the IHS Importation of Processed Animal Feeds of Plant Origin (BNZ-PAFP-IMPRT) must be complied with.

This generic CTO direction takes effect from the date of signing, and applies to irradiated animal feed products potentially containing *Avena sativa*, *Hordeum vulgare*, *Helianthus annuus*, *Lupinus augustifolius*, *Vicia faba* and *Zea mays* whole seed
