This email seeks your comment on the attached draft public notice. Please let me know if I should also be sending it to someone else for comment too.

The draft public notice notifies the three freshwater mataitai reserve applications at Kaikoura, advertises a public meeting to be held with the local community, and calls for submissions (also from the local community).

Submissions from fishing interests will be called for by a second consultation round, but of course commercial fishers are welcome to attend the public meeting too.

I have left the time and date of the public meeting blank, because I am still working out possible dates with my MPI colleagues. I haven't contacted [REDACTED] yet about Sir Mark's diary (yesterday [REDACTED] suggested it would be a good idea if he could attend).

I spoke with [REDACTED] yesterday. The Marae is free on the evenings of Wed 28 October and Thur 29 October, we only need one of those evenings though. [REDACTED] noted that the Zone Committee will be in Kaikoura on the 28<sup>th</sup>. [REDACTED] suggested that they should attend the mataitai meeting, if they can.

MPI will organise publication of the public notice. Potential publication details are the Marlborough Express on Wed 14 Oct and Sat 24 Oct, and the Kaikoura Star on Wed 21 Oct.
