Equivalent measures for consignments non-compliant with VEHICLE-ALL

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTO Plants: 2017 0034

Pursuant to section 27(1) (d) (iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, _____, give the following direction for measures that differ from those required by section 4.3 in the IHS: *Vehicles, Machinery and Tyres* – VEHICLE-ALL and that may be applied to the specified yachts (1 x Jeanneau 46, 1 x Selene 60 and 1 x Navigator 53) that are being shipped as cargo to New Zealand from Genoa, Italy on the "Damgracht".

The measures consist of

1. Full visual inspection of the craft by Sevenstar Yacht Transport personnel, or their agent, prior to leaving the port of departure to check for presence of any Brown Marmorated Stink Bug;
2. Physical cleaning of the craft;
3. Treatment of all parts of the craft with heat to 50°C for 20mins;
4. A certificate being provided with the treatment details; and
5. Inspection by MPI on arrival prior to discharge.

All other relevant sections of the IHS: VEHICLE-ALL for vehicles and machinery sourced from Italy must be complied with.

This direction takes effect from the 1 November 2017, and may apply to the above yachts that Sevenstar Yacht Transport are shipping on the "Damgracht" which are not compliant with the measures required by section 4.3 in the IHS: VEHICLE-ALL.
