



## Appendix 1 CTO Direction to MPI Inspector

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTOPlantsDir:20180008

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Peter Thomson, give the following directions for consignments of wood, imported under permit, to be given biosecurity clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those required by section 2.6(7), and 2.7(1) & (2) in the import health standard (IHS) PPRSWOOD: *Poles, Piles, Rounds and Sleepers from All Countries*; or section 2.6(6), and 2.7(1) & (2) of the IHS SWOOD *Sawn Wood from All Countries*:

- Door inspection by MPI of the sea container for flying insects to take place within the metropolitan area of the port of arrival.
- Directed by an inspector to a transitional facility where processing with heat and/or chemicals is the importer's business activity.
- The facility, operating manual, systems and procedures satisfy the inspector that biosecurity risk will be managed.
- The operator of the facility will heat and/or chemically dip all unlabeled imported wood as per the Operating Manual and MPI inspector's directions.

All other relevant sections of the IHS PPRSWOOD or IHS SWOOD must be complied with.
