

Day-Old Chicks and Hatching Eggs Transiting/Transhipping Singapore (Guidance)

Effective from 1 July 2019

1 Purpose

(1) This guidance document has been issued to accompany *Day-Old Chicks and Hatching Eggs Transiting/Transhipping Singapore (OMAR)*. This guidance document should be read in conjunction with that OMAR.

2 Specific guidance for the transit/transhipment certificate

(1) The transit/transhipment certificate is only intended for transit/transhipment as defined in the OMAR and not for the permanent export of day-old chicks and hatching eggs of poultry to Singapore.

3 Additional information

- (1) Singapore has advised that exporters require a licence to transit/tranship day-old chicks and hatching eggs via Singapore.
- (2) A licence to import/export/tranship animals, birds' eggs and biologicals can be obtained through the Agri-Food and Veterinary Authority's (AVA's) LicenseOne platform.
- (3) The required supporting documentation and associated fees are also outlined on the LicenceOne site.
- (4) To transact with the Singapore Government agencies online platform, including the use of LicenceOne, requires a 'Corppass' corporate digital identity for businesses. For more information refer to: <u>www.corppass.gov.sg</u>.
