1 Proposed Viet Nam Audit of New Zealand Cervine Production Chain Update

- (1) The listings of New Zealand cervine premises for Viet Nam were suspended in 2017 following a change in administrative responsibility from the National Agro-Forestry-Fisheries Quality Assurance Department to the Department of Animal Health (DAH). Exports of cervine products cannot resume until an audit and re-listing has occurred.
- (2) DAH are currently unable to confirm a date for an in-country audit due to the current African Swine Fever outbreak in Viet Nam. Despite several attempts by MPI a date has not been confirmed.
- (3) Expressions of interest were requested in FYI F5/19 "Viet Nam Cervine Audit". New listing requests will only be sent to Viet Nam once an audit date has been confirmed.
- (4) Further information will be provided once MPI can confirm a date range but this is unlikely to occur this year.
