Description of content: The Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) has amended the Import Health Standard for Primates from Australia, Canada, the European Union, USA and Singapore. The amended standard allows for all species (with the exception macaques) of primates holding a containment approval by the Environmental Protection Authority to be imported. 7.
