



## Quarterly Progress Summary: January to March 2019

*Red Meat Profit Partnership*

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### Summary of progress during this quarter

- 124 RMPP Action Network Action Groups with an approved Extension Plan and undertaking activity.
- Launch of version 2.0 of the online KPI tools to make them more user friendly.

### Key highlights and achievements

- The “*Farm Business Transition and Succession*” workshop series started with positive feedback received from participants. Interest from those in regional areas not covered so far and there is a waiting list for 2020.
- Roll out of “*Taking Ownership of Your Financials*” workshop to RMPP Action Network Action Groups.
- 465 Rural Professionals have completed facilitator training and 92 approved to facilitate RMPP Action Network Action Groups.
- “*Understanding Your Farming Business*” programme started in February 2019, with 211 women registered, across the 15 locations.
- Approximately 1,300 farmers using electronic Animal Status Declaration (eASD).

### Collaboration with other PGP programmes

- RMPP presented Action Network progress and learnings to date to DINZ Advanced Parties team.
- Meetings with E350 extension to explore complementary opportunities for associated farmers.

### Upcoming

- *Farm Business Transition and Succession* and *Aspiring to Farm Business Ownership* workshop series roll out continues.
- Offer *Taking Ownership of Your Financials* workshop wider than just RMPP Action Network Action Groups.
