# Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2019

Portfolio Fisheries

On 5 November 2019, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that on 22 August 2019, the Cabinet Environment, Energy and Climate Committee:
  - 1.1 noted the 2016 Kaikōura earthquake had a significant impact on pāua in the northern part of the PAU 3 (Canterbury) and the southern part of the PAU 7 (Marlborough) quota management areas;
  - 1.2 noted the commercial Total Allowable Commercial Catch for PAU 3 and PAU 7 was reduced from 1 October 2017;
  - agreed to decrease the daily recreational limit for pāua in PAU 3 and PAU 7 from 10 pāua to five, and reduce the accumulation limit from 20 pāua or 2.5 kg of minced meat to 10 pāua or 1.25 kg of minced meat in PAU 3 and PAU 7;

- 2 **noted** that the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2019 give effect to the above decision;
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2019 [PCO 22395/8.0];
- 4 **noted** that the Amendment Regulations come into force on 12 December 2019.
