



Canine Semen to New Caledonia (Guidance)

NCDOGSEM9

Effective from 29 May 2020

1 Purpose

- (1) This guidance document has been issued to accompany *Canine Semen to New Caledonia (OMAR)*. This guidance document should be read in conjunction with that OMAR.

2 Specific guidance for the zoosanitary certificate

- (1) With regards to clause 3.1, whilst the donor animal must not have been vaccinated against rabies with a live rabies vaccine, it is acceptable for the donor animal to have been vaccinated against rabies using an inactivated rabies vaccination.

3 Additional information

Further guidance in relation to the completing of the export certificate template is clarified below.

- (1) All fields with < > brackets, present throughout the certificate, are to be completed. This includes the fields which are contained in clauses; 1, 3.2 and 3.4 in the certificate.
 - Name and address of consignor means the name and address of the exporter. This is the registered exporter's name and address, or if a registered exporter is not being used, the sender's name and address.
 - Licence means the registered exporters approval number. If a registered exporter is not being used, this field can be deleted.
 - Name and address of owner means the name and address of the donor animal.
 - Name and address of consignee means the name and address of the recipient in New Caledonia.
 - Date and place of collection means the date and place where the semen was collected.
