Forestry in the Emissions Trading Scheme – post-1989

This form must be completed by both:

- an executor, administrator, or representative for the estate of the deceased
- the successor (this could be an incorporated or unincorporated body, or one or more individuals) of the forestry interest in the estate.

This form must be submitted as soon as possible after the estate containing the post-1989 forest land is transferred from the executor or administrator to the successor.

More than one title can be transferred in a single transaction if they are being transferred to and from the same parties, at the same time on the same date.

Additional requirements

- The executor must provide the pages in the probate that appoint a person to act on behalf of the deceased.
- The executor must notify the Environmental Protection Authority and update the New Zealand Emissions Trading Register (NZETR) holding account information.

If you are the executor or administrator for more than one estate, you must treat them separately for the purposes of the Climate Change Response Act 2002. This includes submitting any emissions returns separately and fulfilling any ETS obligations for each estate.

If the post-1989 forest land is registered as standard forestry:

1. Log-in to Tupu-ake – Forestry ETS online services, available at www.mpi.govt.nz/ets-online-system/
2. Select the service **Tell us about a change to ownership, rights or leases > Tell us the land owner has changed > Post-1989 forest land (standard)**.
3. Upload the completed form and your shapefile to the file upload on the main summary page.

If the post-1989 forest land is registered as permanent forestry:

1. Log-in to Tupu-ake – Forestry ETS online services, available at www.mpi.govt.nz/ets-online-system/
2. Select the service **Tell us about a change to ownership, rights or leases > Tell us the land owner has changed > Post-1989 forest land (permanent)**.
3. Upload the completed form and your shapefile to the file upload on the main summary page.

We will process your notification and contact you about the outcome. You must complete an emissions return as soon as practicable after you submit this form. To submit your emissions return, use the emissions return (succession) form available at www.mpi.govt.nz/ETSforms

This transfer is not complete until you submit the emissions return.

If this transfer results in you having 100 or more hectares of forest land in the ETS, you will need to establish sample plots on your land for measuring your forest. This is sometimes known as the Field Measurement Approach. Find out more on our website:
