Dairy: Zoological Certificate

CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of dairy products for human consumption from the European Union and Switzerland.

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for dairy products for human consumption from the European Union and Switzerland to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable import health standard for milk and milk products for human consumption from the European Union and Switzerland (DAIEDIIC.EEC):

Part D. Zoological Certificate no longer needs to include the following statement: VI. This certificate is valid for 4 months from the date of issue (unless revoked)

This statement has no influence on the biosecurity risk of the commodity and therefore is no longer needed on the zoological certificate.

The reason for directing clearance is that the biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and are managed effectively.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
