## CTO direction to biosecurity inspectors for the clearance of UK salmon product via Australia

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Imports, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following direction for UK salmon product imported into New Zealand from Australia to be given clearance in accordance with the assessment of equivalence to the Import Health Standard for the Importation into New Zealand of Salmonids for Human Consumption from Australia (FISSALIC.AUS; 16 August 2000):

The nature of the non-compliance is that the above import health standard does not have provisions for allowing third country salmon products to be imported from Australia. This consignment pertains to salmon sourced and processed in the UK and released by quarantine for sale in Australia.

The reason for directing clearance is that the biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and will be effectively managed. The salmon product is processed and commercially packaged for direct retail sale and subject to the following import conditions:

• Consignment pertaining to MPI's Permit to Import # 2014054872 only; must not be applied to other consignments or import permits.
