## 2 Issues identified

18 October 2023	All	The competent authority of Tonga has suspended the import of dayold chicks and hatching eggs from specified export approved premises as a result of some source breeder flocks in New Zealand testing serologically positive to Egg Drop Syndrome '76. The export of day-old chicks and hatching eggs from other export approved premises may still be possible.	The competent authority of Tonga is currently reviewing their import requirements for day-old chicks and hatching eggs. MPI will issue an updated BIRDOHEC.TO OMAR after Tonga communicates their revised import requirements.
