

Appendix 1: CTO Direction – Processed animal feeds from MSM Milling or Manildra Flour Mills

Pursuant to sections 27 and 104 of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, _____, give the following directions for consignments of processed stockfeed from MSM Milling or Manildra Flour Mills to be imported under the following equivalent conditions:

- A permit to import is issued to specify that consignments with direct loading of product, container bulkheads and liners and insecticide treatment in transit is equivalent to the pre-export fumigation requirement in section 3.1.6 and 3.2.3 of the import health standard (IHS) BNZ-PAFP-IMPRT *Importation into New Zealand of Processed Animal Feeds of Plant Origin*, which effectively manages the risks identified in the IHS. The manufacturer will confirm using a fumigation or manufacturer's certificate that consignments have been loaded with an insecticide treatment that will be applied during transit.
- Consignments will have to meet all other requirements as per Section 7.3 of the IHS.
