attach a map of the sampling extent, please let me know if you'd like the shapefile or coordinates. We only sampled a small area (0.4 ha or about 64 m by 64 m) in the north-eastern corner as there were no pipi in adjacent areas in November 2023.

The current sampling extent was about half the size of the area we sampled previously.

When we surveyed in February, there had been substantial recruitment, similar to other Northland sites.

Based on the sampling, the current pipi population estimates for Marsden Bank were 0.45 million (CV: 15.66%) pipi, or 120 pipi per square metre. There were no large pipi (>50 mm shell length) and the population was dominated by recruits (<20 mm shell length). They made up 87.57% of the current population, and the remainder were medium-sized pipi. Mean and modal shell lengths were 15.49 and 13 mm.

Given the small sizes of pipi, it will be interesting to see what proportion of the pipi population will persist at Marsden Bank.
