

**CONTROLLED AREA NOTICE  
NOTICE UNDER THE BIOSECURITY ACT 1993**

**SECTION 131 - DECLARATION OF CONTROLLED AREA AND NOTICE OF MOVEMENT  
CONTROLS AND PROCEDURES IN RESPECT OF ORIENTAL FRUIT FLY - *Bactrocera dorsalis***

**Commencement**

1. This Declaration and Notice takes effect at 1030HRS on 21 February 2025.

**Controlled Area Declaration**

2. Under section 131(2) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I declare that the area described in Schedule 1 ("the Controlled Area") is the area that is controlled in order to:
  - a. Enable the limitation of the spread of Oriental Fruit Fly being an unwanted organism under the Biosecurity Act 1993;
  - b. Minimise the damage caused by Oriental Fruit Fly;
  - c. Protect New Zealand from an incursion of Oriental Fruit Fly;
  - d. Facilitate the access of New Zealand products to overseas markets; and
  - e. Monitor risks associated with the movement Oriental Fruit Fly from parts of New Zealand where the Oriental Fruit Fly status is unknown.

**Notice of Movement Controls**

3. Under section 131(3)(a) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I give notice that, except with the written permission of an inspector or authorised person appointed under section 103 of the Biosecurity Act 1993, and in compliance with any conditions imposed by an inspector or authorised person -
  - a. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) that are in Controlled Area Zone A (Schedule 1) must not be moved outside Zone A; and
  - b. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) that are in the Controlled Area Zone B (Schedule 1) must not be moved outside Zone B; and
  - c. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) that are in Controlled Area Zone A (Schedule 1), and things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) that are in Controlled Area Zone B, must not be disposed of by putting out for collection by municipal rubbish, food waste, or recycling collectors, other than in biosecurity waste bins provided by Biosecurity New Zealand.
4. Things listed in Schedule 3 may be moved into Controlled Area Zones A and B.

**Schedule 1 Description of Controlled Area**

The following areas are included in the Controlled Area and subject to this Notice:

**Zone A**

Controlled Area (Zone A) is the area within an approximately 200-metre radius of a point in Roseneath Place, Birkdale, Auckland as listed below and as defined in the map in Schedule 2.

*Description of boundaries of Zone A*

1. Starting at the intersection of Beach Haven Road and Hellyers Street, heading south to meet the Flaxdale Street roundabout.
2. From the Flaxdale Street roundabout, head in an east direction to meet Birkdale Road.
3. Head north up Birkdale Road to meet the Birkdale Road and Levesque Street intersection.
4. Head in an east direction along Levesque Street to meet the intersection of Lauderdale Road.
5. Follow Lauderdale Road in a northern direction to meet Ivy Place.
6. Boundary then follows even numbered properties, from 2 – 24 (inclusive), along Ivy Place.
7. Boundary then heads in a northern direction, following the coastline until reaching Beach Haven Road.
8. Head in a western direction until reaching Beach Haven Road and Hellyers Street intersection once again.

**Zone B**

Controlled Area (Zone B) is the area within an approximately 1.5-kilometre radius of a point in Roseneath Place, Birkdale, Auckland as listed below and as defined in the map in Schedule 2 but excluding Controlled Area (Zone A).

*Description of boundaries of Zone B*

1. Starting at the Hale Crescent and Lynn Road intersection, heading south along Lynn Road.
2. Continue on Manuka Road in a southern and then eastern direction until the Manuka Road and Easton Park Parade intersection.
3. Follow Easton Park Parade in a southern direction until the Kaipātiki Road roundabout.
4. Follow Kaipātiki Road in a south-western direction until the Kaipātiki Road and Stanley Road roundabout.
5. Head in a southern direction on Stanley Road, continuing along Roberts Road in an eastern direction to meet Roberts Road and Glenfield Road intersection.
6. Head in a southern direction along Glenfield Road to meet the intersection of Glenfield Road and Eskdale Road.
7. Head in a western direction along Eskdale Road and continue straight along Inglis Street until the end of the street.
8. The boundary then cuts through Ridgewood Reserve to meet the end of Verran Road.
9. Head in a western direction along Verran Road to meet the Verran Road and Rangatira Road roundabout.
10. Follow along Rangatira Road until meeting the intersection of Rangatira Road and Rosecamp Road.

11. Head in a western direction along Rosecamp Road until the end of the road.
12. Boundary then heads in a northern direction, following the coastline until reaching the boundary of 14 and 15 Hotspur Place.
13. Follow Hotspur Place in an eastern direction to meet the intersection of Hotspur Place and Hale Crescent.
14. Follow Hale Crescent in a north-eastern direction until reaching the Hale Crescent and Lynn Road intersection once again.

### **Specific Properties in Zone A**

Where a property is bisected by the boundary of Zone A of the Controlled Area, the entire property is included in Zone A of the Controlled Area.

### **Specific Properties in Zone B**

Where a property is bisected by the boundary of Zone B of the Controlled Area, the entire property is included in the Controlled Area.

## **Schedule 3 – Things subject to Movement Controls**

### Zone A

1. **Zone A fruit and vegetables**, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables, except for:
  - a. leafy vegetables; and
  - b. root vegetables; and
  - c. cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
2. Packaging materials associated with Zone A fruit and vegetables.
3. Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees wherever grown.
4. Compost and green waste that contains fruit and vegetables.

### Zone B

1. **Zone B fruit and vegetables**, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables grown inside Zone B, except for:
  - a. leafy vegetables; and
  - b. root vegetables; and
  - c. cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
2. Packaging materials associated with Zone B fruit and vegetables.
3. Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees grown inside Zone B.
4. Compost and green waste that contains Zone B fruit and vegetables.
