This Administrative Standard facilitates confident and credible domestic and international marketing of New Zealand grass-based farming systems and their products, a key point of difference for the quality, taste, and nutrition of dairy from New Zealand.

It provides recognition by the New Zealand Ministry for Primary Industries that milk from dairy farm operators or processors that are certified to a Scheme recognised under this Standard have met the requirements and attributes for New Zealand Grass-Fed.

Dairy products that meet the New Zealand Grass-Fed Administrative Standard and are licensed to carry the Grass-Fed FernMark logo are producing milk from herds that:
