Frequently used terms

Dual Operator Butcher = an operator that operated a retail butchery to sell and/or process regulated meat AND process homekill or recreational catch at the same premise as the retail butchery.

Evaluator = A recognised person that checks an RMP covers the operations and, as written, will deliver product that is fit for intended purpose. An evaluator is only necessary for RMP's that are not fully based on an approved Code of Practice, template or model.

GST = Goods and services tax

Homekill and recreational catch service provider = an operator who provides slaughter and or/processing services for reward to animal owners for homekill or to hunters, fishers or other harvesters for recreational catch **MPI** = Ministry for Primary Industries

RMP = Risk Management Programme

Required Parts = Previously known as an "outline". When you apply to register your RMP, you can choose to submit your entire RMP, or to submit only certain parts. The parts you must submit are stated in the Animal Products Regulations 2021.
