The following communication, received on 28 02 2013, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of New Zealand.

Import Health Standard for Pig Semen

This Import Health Standard provides New Zealand's mitigation measures for a number of diseases related to pig semen. These are generic measures and bilateral veterinary certificates will be negotiated with countries that New Zealand approves importations of pig semen from. Current approved countries are Australia, Canada, European Union, Norway and the United States of America. Changes have been made to risk management measures for specific diseases (African Swine Fever, Blue Eye Disease, and Transmissible Gastroenteritis).
