for Food Waste Supply and Collection

Part A: For the Food Waste Supplier

If you supply food waste that contains meat or has been in contact with meat for feeding to pigs the <u>Biosecurity (Meat and Food Waste for Pigs)</u> Regulations 2005 apply to you. Clause 6 of the regulations requires you to either supply food waste treated according to the rules, or you have reasonable grounds to believe that the collector will treat it according to the rules before feeding to pigs. Though not a regulatory requirement, this <u>undertaking</u>, when completed, will demonstrate your compliance with these regulations.

Actions for food waste supplier							
Ask the food waste collector to provide the necessary information in <i>Part B</i> . The Ministry for Primary Industries recommends obtaining this undertaking even if the food waste will not contain meat or is unlikely to have been in contact with meat.

Part B: Food Waste Collector's Undertaking							
I, the undersigned, understand that under the <u>Biosecurity (Meat and Food Waste for Pigs) Regulations 2005</u> it is an offence to feed non-compliant food waste to pigs. I agree to comply with the requirements of these regulations. In particular, if the food waste may contain meat or may have had contact with meat as declared by the Food Waste Supplier above, I will heat the food waste to 100 degrees Celsius for one hour before feeding it to pigs.							
I accept that as a condition of supply of the food waste to me, the food waste supplier will forward this undertaking to the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI), who may send me educational materials. MPI officers may also check my premises for compliance with the Regulations.							
I also understand that I have rights to contact MPI for accessing and correcting my contact details in accordance with Principles 6 and 7 in Section 6 of the Privacy Act 1993.
