Proposed amendment to the Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Animal Consumption) Notice 2006

The Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) has proposed changes to improve and update the requirements relating to petfood. The review was carried out as a result of the feedback that the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) received from stakeholders and the New Zealand Petfood Manufacturers Association (NZPFMA). The proposed amendments for your consideration include:

- including wild goats and deer as a source of petfood;
- change the requirements for keeping a wild possums head attached for transport;
- extending the 30 day landowner declaration to 3 months; and
- removing the requirement for poison use statements for farmed mammals.

Additionally MPI is consulting on a renewal system and charges for the further petfood processors listing process.

It is proposed that there will be no transition period and all suppliers and operators will be required to meet the new requirements once the Notice is issued. If stakeholders have any concerns around the transition period this should be noted in their submission.
