SNAPPER ONE REGION Rule Change 1 April

The bag and size limits for snapper in the Snapper 1 region are changing on 1 April

- » The **bag limit** is changing to 7 snapper per fisher per day (previously 9).
- » The **minimum legal size** is increasing to 30cm (from 27cm).
- » The **Snapper 1 Region** covers the East Coast between North Cape and Cape Runaway out to a distance of 200 nautical miles.
- » Changes apply only to the Snapper 1 area. There are no changes outside this area.
- » The changes to the Snapper 1 bag and size limits are part of a long term plan to improve New Zealand's most valuable inshore finfish fishery.



- » Care should be taken when handling and returning snapper below the minimum legal size. Advice on good fish handling practices is available through our website.
- » Fishing rules and restrictions can, and do, change regularly so check the rules before you fish.
